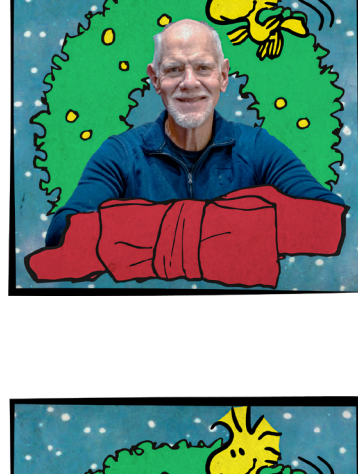
CAST BIOS
